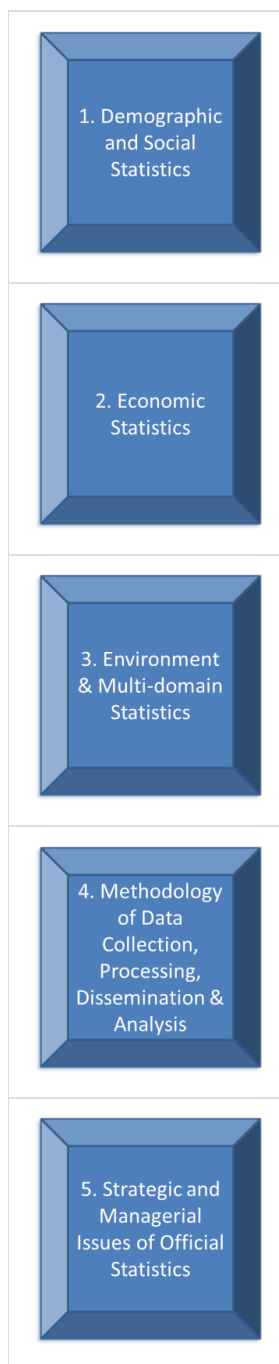

While the seminar was about census data, the presentation is not specific to censuses but is more widely applicable to the dissemination of statistical data in any domain.

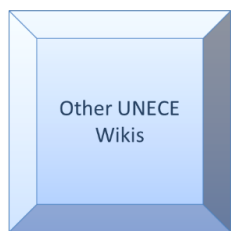
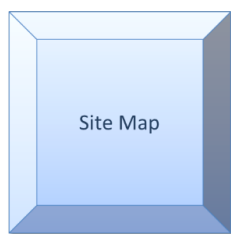
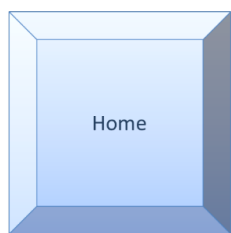
