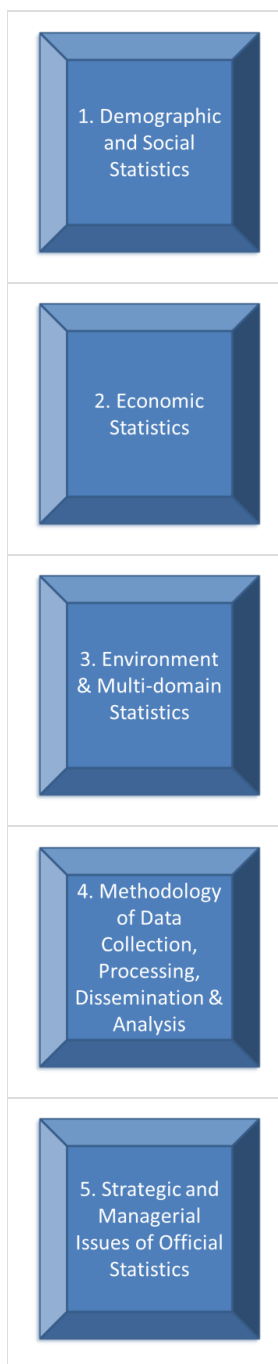

The key considerations discussed in the presentation are:


- Ask basic census questions, and tabulate the answers

- Build capacity for collection and dissemination.




